- Strengthen the competences of adult education providers (AEP), developing innovative pedagogical approach on recycling;
- Improve the cooperation between public authorities and the private sector to develop innovative tools for the social inclusion of disadvantaged adults;
- Promote the integration process of migrants/refugees and ethnic minorities to the general public and make them part of this process.
