

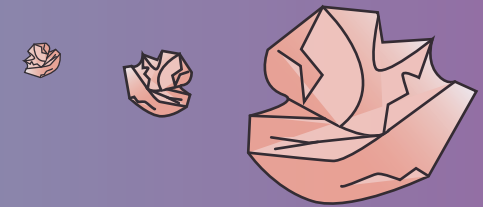


Objectives

- 🌿 Promote the integration process of migrants/refugees and ethnic minorities to the general public and make them part of this process.
